The World Communion of Reformed Churches (WCRC) is seeking a General Secretary to be the Chief Executive Officer of WCRC who will be responsible to the General Council and the Executive Committee to direct and coordinate the work of the communion. Applicants must be and/or be capable of being:

- an ordained clergy of a member church
- provide spiritual leadership
- have a firm commitment to the Reformed faith
- have appropriate theological training

- have familiarity with current international issues
- have sensitivity to cultural and theological diversity, gender issues and youth concerns
